A Home for Hardy: From Quarantine to Cherished Companion

Hardy's journey is one of resilience, love, and finding the perfect match when it was least expected. Born at the shelter to an unhealthy feral mother, Hardy's start in life was anything but easy. His compromised immune system meant frequent battles with upper respiratory infections and persistent eye issues that eventually required the surgical removal of one eye.

Because of his health challenges, Hardy spent much of his first year in the shelter being transferred back and forth to our quarantine areas for treatment. This meant he often missed out on being visible in our adoption areas, making it harder for him to find a forever home. Through it all, Hardy became a fixture at the shelter, forming strong bonds with our staff. He was so affectionate that he earned the unofficial title of "office cat," brightening our days and—at times—making it nearly impossible to get any work done with his relentless requests for cuddles.

Hardy's story took a heartwarming turn when the residents of Forest Manor, a local assisted living facility, needed a little affection of their own. One of their residents, accompanied by an employee, visited our shelter and met Hardy in the office. It was love at first sight. They knew Hardy was the perfect match for their community.

Today, Hardy is thriving in his new role as the beloved companion of the residents at Forest Manor. Surrounded by people who adore him, he spends his days soaking up all the affection he so richly deserves. Hardy's journey from a sickly kitten to a cherished companion reminds us why we do what we do—every life matters, and every animal deserves a chance to find their perfect home.

DOGGIE'S DAY OUT - A NEW PROGRAM LOVED BY DOGS AND VOLUNTEERS







Dear Friends,

As we near the end of 2024, I want to take a moment to reflect on the incredible difference you've made this year for the animals in our care and for our community.

Thanks to your generosity, we accomplished so much together:

- Provided shelter, food, and medical care to 1,900 local animals in need.
- Launched and expanded programs like our Community Cat Program, helping to significantly reduce the local cat population by preventing unwanted pregnancies and reducing the spread of preventable diseases.
- Held free vaccine and microchip clinics and low-cost spay and neuter events to keep pets safe and healthy.
- Supported families with pets affected by the devastating tornado that tore through our town in May, thanks to disaster relief grants from PetSmart Charities and Petco Love.

In addition to these milestones, your support helped us rise to the challenge of Petco Love's matching grant. Because of you, we met our 2nd and 3rd quarter goals of raising \$25,000 each, unlocking \$100,000 in total funding so far this year to help the animals who need us most.

Now, as we enter the final quarter of this challenge, we have one last opportunity to meet our goal and unlock the full \$150,000 potential of this grant. Raising another \$25,000 by December 31 will allow us to continue providing life-saving care and compassionate services for animals and families in our community.

If the pandemic taught us anything, it's that we never know what tomorrow will bring. The same is true for the animals who find their way to us—each one with their own story of hardship and hope. Your support ensures that, no matter the obstacles, we'll be here to continue to provide homeless animals with the care and compassion they deserve.
